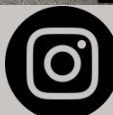
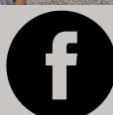

Warm greetings to you!

IMPACT PROGRAMS



While IMPACT60 is primarily a community conduit, we have created programs aimed to enhance the well-being of people, places and things around us. Below you will see a snip of these programs. Workforce development is vital to the health of communities. TAP is a free 10-week auto lab experience led by master techs. Target audience: persons in the judicial system, teens seeking a path. 79 have enrolled since the inception of TAP; 29% found employment.



i60 has established a budgetary line item specifically to assist vetted persons in need of urgent assistance where no agency or organization can fill the immediate gap. Help ranges from car repairs and basic needs donations, to rent stabilization, transportation and hotel stays in emergency situations.



The first of its kind in the NW33 smart corridor, 'iStation' is a 24/7 emergency shelter with 28 beds and full case management provided by experienced partner, Family Promise of Delaware County. The Union County Family YMCA is a vital partner and the space lessor.

IMPACT60 supports direct client impact in the following areas (but not limited to): food insecurity, transportation, homelessness, wellness, mental health, recovery, community-centered awareness & culture programs, assistance for animal well-being and therapies for humans, youth pro-social engagement and workforce initiatives for marginalized populations. 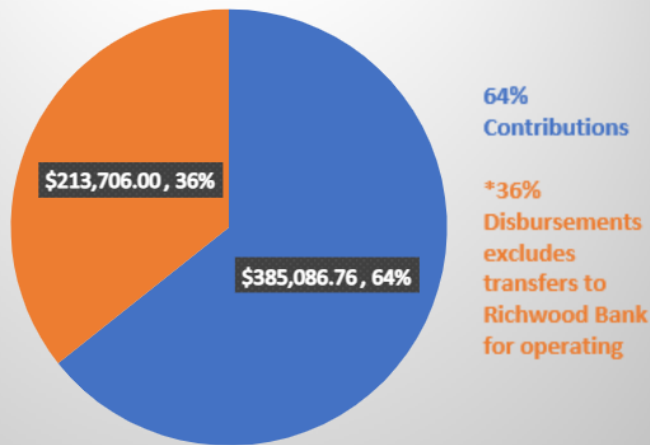

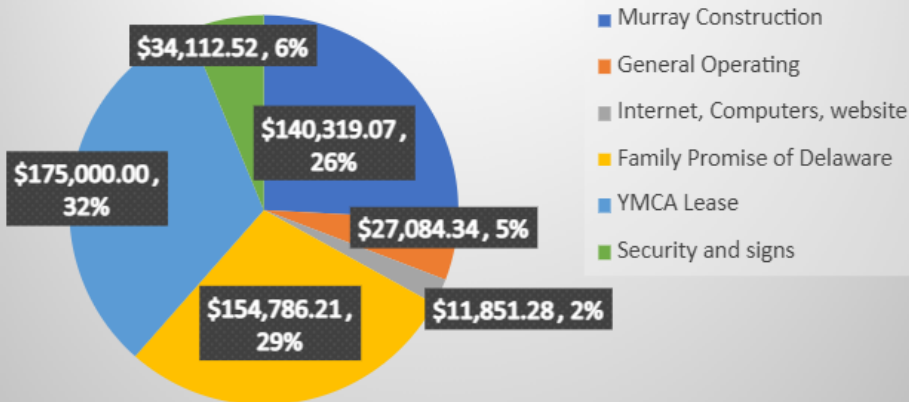
OVERVIEW OF FINANCES

TO DATE \$543, 153.42

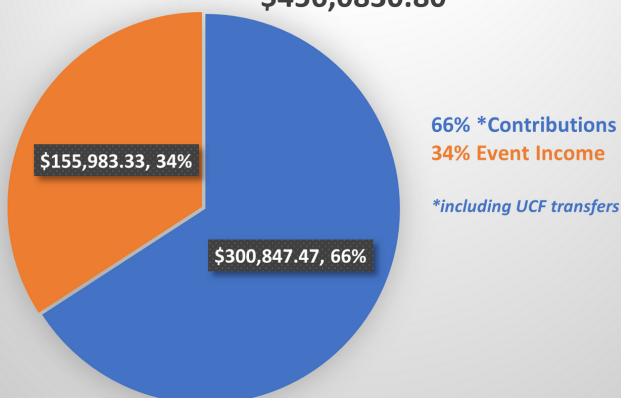


Our biggest undertaking to date is a 24/7 emergency shelter in Union County. Annual operating cost projection: \$450,000.

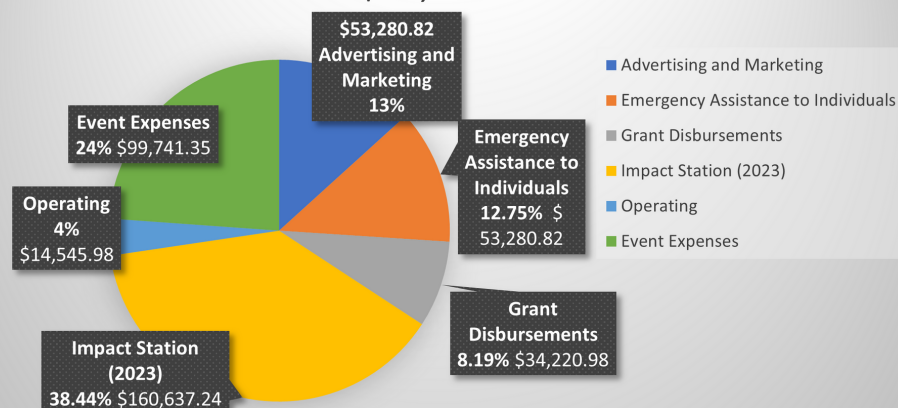
In order to operate i60 programs and to make big impacts with emergency assistance, a checking account is maintained at Richwood Bank.

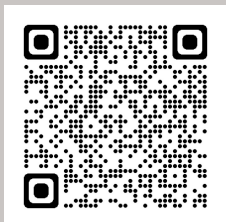
